Faith, Wellness, and You

Every year, on May 31st, the World Health Organization and partners mark World No Tobacco Day. This day highlights the health and additional risks associated with tobacco use and advocates for effective policies to reduce tobacco consumption. The World Health Organization calls upon countries to prioritize and accelerate tobacco control efforts. All countries benefit from successfully controlling the tobacco epidemic. It is not only governments who can step up tobacco control efforts: people can contribute on an individual basis as well. People can commit to never take up tobacco products, those who do use tobacco can quit the habit, or seek help in doing so. Quitting tobacco can also help protect the health of people exposed to second-hand smoke, including children and other family members/friends. About 6 million people die from tobacco use every year, a figure that is predicted to grow to more than 8 million a year by 2030. Tobacco use costs national economies enormously through increased healthcare costs and decreased productivity.

Did you know...? If you are thinking about quitting tobacco, but need some help, there is a QuitPlan helpline (888-354-7526). They offer text message tips, emails, a quit guide, and 2 weeks of free patches, gum or lozenges (available to Minnesota adults- 18 or older).
