Faith, Wellness, and You

June is Men's Health Month. The purpose of men's health month is to heighten the awareness of preventable health problems and encourage early detection and treatment of diseases. Men of all ages, should have their blood pressure checked yearly, as well as a rectal exam. Men should have a physical exam, blood work, and urine tested every 1-3 years, depending on age. An EKG (to check for heart abnormalities) should be done at least every 2 years after age 30. Tetanus booster needs to be given every 10 years. PSA (blood test for prostate cancer) should be done every year after age 50 unless high risk. Self exams are to be done monthly. Self exams include: testicles to find lumps, skin to find changing moles, oral to find lesions in the mouth, and breasts to find abnormal lumps. Did you know ...? If you have any questions about what type of screenings should be done, your primary care

provider is an excellent resource to answer all of your questions, and most insurance plans cover preventive exams/screenings. You can contact your parish nurses at: Diane: 218-255-1270 and Tiffany at 218-252-8227.
