Faith, Wellness, and You

June is cataract awareness month. Cataract is a clouding of the eye's lens which blocks or changes the passage of light into the eye. They can develop slowly or quickly, and can even progress to a certain point then not get any worse. Cataract is responsible for 51% of the world's blindness according to the World Health Organization. It is estimated that there are 25.7 million individuals with cataracts in the United States. Besides aging, cataracts form due to eye infections, medications, injuries, radiation, and too much exposure to non-visible sunlight (UV light). The treatment for cataracts is surgery, and 90% of surgeries have improved vision afterwards. Did you know...? You should talk with your eye care professional about what treatment is right for you.
