Faith, Wellness, and You

During these summer months, boating becomes a very popular past time. Enjoying Minnesota lakes and rivers by boat or canoe is a wonderful privilege that comes with serious responsibilities. State law requires children less than 10 years of age to wear a life jacket while a boat is underway. A readily accessible and wearable life jacket is required for each person onboard a boat. A throwable is also required on boats over 16 feet or longer and must be immediately available. Boating tips include: being weather wise, using common sense, developing a float plan, making proper use of lifejackets, avoiding alcohol, learning to swim and taking a boating course.

Did you know.... 53 people died in Minnesota related to a boating fatality or non-boating drowning in 2015, making it very important to use life jackets properly.
