Corrective surgery is needed in order to take care of these problems. Harrington rods will be inserted in the back along the spine. As of right now the scoliosis pulls his shoulder blades out causing him great pain and without the surgery he will develop many health problems as he gets older. With a surgery like this comes a great expense. While insurance covers some of it, there is still a lot of remaining cost.
