

Discerning the Diaconate –The next formation group for the permanent diaconate will begin in the Fall of 2024. In the Fall of 2023 into the Winter 2024 there will be a number of "Discerning" the Diaconate" sessions offered around the Diocese and via zoom for men, and spouses if married, so that they can find out more about the program. Who is eligible to be a Permanent Deacon? While there are a number of official requirements decreed by the Church (e.g. between the ages of 35-65 at time of ordination) the more important requirement is to have an active life in the Church, the interest in growing in the model of Christ the servant in order to serve the people of God, a motivation to learn more about the Church, and, if married, being in a stable marriage with a wife who is supportive.
