#### Oil for your Lamp

The readings of Holy Week can be a little overwhelming. because there is so much to reflect upon. A few years ago, as I was finishing up with chemotherapy, I made a decision to consecrate myself to Mary; to consecrate means to set aside for a specific purpose. The book that I have used every year to renew this consecration, is called "33 Days to Morning Glory" and it contains a month-long self-retreat, which is broken down into 4 separate weeks focusing on 4 different Saints who had a deep devotion to Mary. One of those saints, Mother Teresa of Calcutta, encourages us to focus on the final words of Jesus, "I Thirst". In his final moments of life in human form, I would imagine that Jesus' voice was not booming out for all to hear, but only those who were very near him would have heard those words; a few soldiers, Mary, John, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the wife of Clopas. The soldiers were convinced that they understood his desire and rushed to give him a drink of wine. Mary, his mother, must have heard those words when Jesus was very young, and she understood them differently. When the God of the Universe left the comforts of heaven and became man, he entrusted himself to a simple woman, Mary. If Mary could understand the desires of God, she can most certainly understand our sinful desires. On the cross he gave Mary to us when he entrusted her to the disciple he loved. When Jesus knew that all he could do for Mary had been done he gave the world one final gift. That gift was opened by a single thrust of a lance into the side of Jesus. My prayer for all of you is related to that precious gift, more specifically; May Mary, who understood the desires of Jesus, help you to drink of the water the flows from his pierced side.
