This Gospel passage raises more questions than answers. The reason why it raises more questions than answers is because many of us do not take the time to listen as we pray. Prayer is simply communication with God. Break down the word communication and you will find communion. As you approach the Altar to receive the Eucharist, you are living today's Gospel! Jesus is calling you to come forward. As you return to the pew, with his body within yours, you are going your way in faith. When the final words of Mass are said, "Go" Your response is "Thanks be to God", and (hopefully) you follow him on the Way. "To keep a lamp burning, we have to keep putting oil in it." (Saint Teresa of Kolkata)
