Holy Week is Upon Us! With today's celebration of Palm Sunday, we have entered Holy Week, with Thursday, Friday and Saturday comprising the Sacred Triduum - Three Days. The Triduum celebrations are the crowning jewel, if you will, of the entire liturgical year. These three days are treated as one celebration. On Holy Thursday we commemorate the Last Supper, when Jesus turns ordinary bread and wine into His Body and Blood, and we recall how he washed the feet of His disciples; on Good Friday we commemorate the Lord's Passion with the Veneration of the Cross; and the Easter Vigil - the Mother of all liturgies - we recall our salvation history and Jesus' resurrection from the dead. Please join us as we solemnly remember God's glory as we celebrate the Sacred Triduum.

Collections on Holy Thursday and Good Friday will be for the Holy Land. Due to the war taking place, our Christian brothers and sisters in the Holy Land, who usually rely on tourism for their financial support, are in greater need than usual to help keep the holy sites open.
